Director's Report – JULY-AUGUST-SEPTEMBER 2024

OPERATIONS:

- We received the new computer chairs from BroDart purchased with help from the Friends of the Library.
- July, August, and September 2024 were relatively normal operational months, as in we did not see any major disruptions to services.
- The **City of FSJ** and **NPCC** confirmed that the current ceiling lights will be replaced by LEDs that will be much brighter, only require around 40 units (compared to the current 80+), and remove the need for light covers. Which is a major step forward.
